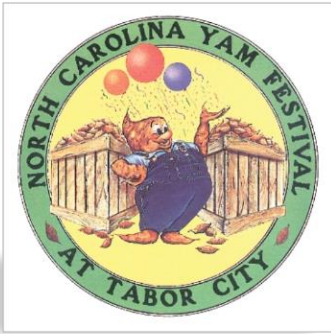

#### **Rules & Regulations:**

1. The 2018 NC Yam Festival: Tabor's Got Talent is open to groups and individuals of all ages.
2. Contestants will compete in one of three divisions, there is a maximum of 30 acts for the show. There will be a limit of 10 acts per division with others placed on a waitlist. Although if by the deadline the maximum 30 acts for the entire show has not been met, entries will be added off of the waiting list until a total of 30 acts is reached.
3. Prizes are awarded in each division for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, & 3<sup>rd</sup> place. New this year, one contestant will be awarded a trophy and cash prize for winning the People's Choice Award.
4. The People's Choice Award is given to the entry with the most votes, each vote cost \$1.00. Contestants are encouraged to invite family and friends to come out and watch the show, a table will be set up to collect money/votes before and during the show. The cash prize given will be half of the total amount of money collect for votes, the other half of money will be donated to Tabor Middle School's Athletic Department.
5. The Talent Show will be held at The Ritz Plaza Stage at 3:00 pm sharp, the day of the NC Yam Festival. Contestants must check in with the event coordinator Erin Mincey by 2:00pm with check in starting at 12:00 pm.
6. Each contestant will be allowed no more than 3.5 minutes on stage and must be ready to perform when it is their turn.
7. Music must be burned on to a CD and presented at check in. Microphones will be available for all acts. Each contestant is responsible for any other props and/or equipment needed for their specific act.
8. The NC Yam Festival is not responsible for any damages, lost, and/or stolen equipment/props.
9. Contestants will be judged on the following content but not limited to; poise, confidence, costume, audience appeal, talent and overall impression. All decisions of the judges are final.
