RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

• **BIRTHDATE:** The division the contestant is in is determined by the age the contestant will be on the evening of the pageant.

• **CONTESTANT CONTRACT:** Each contestant and parent or guardian are REQUIRED to sign the morality contract before competing. Contracts are included in all pageant application packets. A contestant who has been married and or has a child before or during the pageant may not compete. In the event a pageant Queen becomes pregnant out of wedlock and or decides to get married, she will be asked to relinquish her title. The first runner up in her division will be asked to fulfill the duties as Queen. No questions asked and no exceptions. We abide strictly by the morality contract of the Miss North Carolina Yam Festival Scholarship Pageant.

• **RESIDENCY:** NC Yam Festival Pageant is OPEN to residents of North and South Carolina

• **GRACE PERIOD:** Title holders will NOT be allowed to compete in another pageant until 60 days prior to relinquishing the NC Yam Festival Pageant Title on October 7th, 2023. August 9th is the 60-day grace period mark. In the event The NC Yam Festival Teen and Queen honor requirements of the 60 days' time frame prior to competing in another pageant and win the title, the Queens are expected to complete their duties with the NC Yam Festival through October 7th, 2023. NC Yam Festival Pageant Queen is under contract to fulfill ALL NC Yam Festival and Tabor City events. Appearances and requirements are listed in the contestant contract.

• **Required Areas of Competition:**

Baby Miss - Little: Casual Wear (40%) & Beauty (60%)

Junior - Queen: Interview (40%), Talent (30%) & Beauty (30%)

Mrs.: Interview (40%), Casual wear (30%) & Beauty (30%)

Opening Number--All Contestants are required to participate in the opening number. It is NOT a judged portion of the pageant; however, it is the first impression of contestants as a group to greet the audience and judges. All contestants must wear a NC Yam Festival T-Shirt, blue jeans and shoes, No flip flops! T-shirts may be purchased at the Tabor City Public Library or during registration. Additional embellishments are allowed but not required! This is an opportunity to make a great impression and show your sense of style and creativity.

• The Photogenic Contest is an optional area of competition, but not required. It is open to all Contestants. An 8x10 Photo must be submitted the night of rehearsal. Additional photos can be judged for \$10.00 per photo. Photos may be in Color or Black & White. NO HIGH GLITZ! Photos may be touched up. Two Photogenic Awards will be given-- Baby too Little, Young to Mrs.

• Note: NO wigs, extensions, faux teeth, and no excessive makeup etc. The judges are aware of our guidelines and the caliber of Queens we are seeking to represent our Festival and Tabor City. Judges will deduct points for those not complying with our directives and regulations.

• Scoresheets: All Scores are final. In our morality contract we discuss the positive atmosphere and excellent behavior of all contestants, their stylist, and families.

Areas of Competition Information:

· Beauty:

Baby to Little Miss - Sunday Dress attire with matching socks and shoes.

Limit rhinestones and bling

Junior to Mrs.:

Floor length pageant dress. May be Glitzy. Must be age appropriate. *Dresses that fit and compliment the contestant are sure to make the contestant confident. *

· Casual Wear:

Baby to Little Miss & Mrs. only: Must be age appropriate, dressy, neat, and stylish. No midriffs. May be custom made or off the rack. Be creative and show off the contestant's personality. Yam or Fall Themed/Colors. (NO Halloween)

· Interview:

Junior to Mrs. only: Contestants meet individually with judges. Sunday Dress attire for Junior Miss. Business Attire for Young Miss through Mrs. division.

· Talent:

Junior to Queen only: Only CDs are allowed; all music must be cued and only one song allowed on the CD. Talent CANNOT exceed 3 minutes. CD's must be marked with Contestant Name, Division and Contestant number. CD's MUST BE turned in at the beginning of rehearsal to allow the sound crew to check and prepare for the pageant. Please have a backup CD for rehearsal and the night of the pageant.

Awards:

· Division Winners: Each division winner will receive a rhinestone round crown, embroidered satin sash, and trophy. *Baby-Little contestants will receive a complimentary participation tiara*

· Overall Beauty: Baby too Little, Junior to Mrs. - winner will receive a trophy.

· Overall Interview: Junior to Mrs.- winner will receive a trophy.

· Optional Photogenic: Two trophies will be given. Baby too Little, Junior to Queen.

· Scholarship: ONLY Teen and Queen- Teen Miss: \$500, Queen: \$1,000. Scholarship will be received in the form of a check once the year's reign has been completed if all required events were attended, including NO other entry in pageants without director's permission, and conduct has exemplified the requirements set by the NC Yam Festival Pageant Committee.

Court Requirements and information:

NC Yam Festival Royalty will NOT have an all-expense paid reign. The Queens will be

responsible for Cars, Parade Fees, Shirts, Car Signs, Clothing etc. The Yam Festival Committee will attempt to minimize costs whenever it is possible.

Additional Pageant Information

Pageant Rehearsal: Thursday, September 29th @ 6:00 p.m., South Columbus High School

- *All Photogenic entries must be turned in by the end of rehearsal.
 - *Contestant numbers will be given out at rehearsal; no extras will be given.
 - *Programs will be distributed to the contestants.
 - *Schedule for interview appointments will be given.
 - *Contestants will receive 2 passes. May be used for parents, guardians, or hair stylist.
- Pass is required to be backstage with contestants - no exceptions!***
- *No boys or men allowed in dressing rooms. *
 - *There will be a run-through of the pageant to allow contestants to walk the stage layout during rehearsal.
 - *Each contestant will be given a walk-through time which will be allotted for their Talent rehearsal. This is a closed session. Only the contestant, her parents, the pageant directors, and approved pageant committee members will be in this closed session.
 - *Bring two talent accompanying CDs to rehearsal. A second copy will be given to the pageant director for the sound technician to have as a backup copy. CDs must work with our sound system.

Pageant Day: **TENTATIVE SCHEDULE**

Little Queens Pageant: *doors will open @ 9:00 a.m. Pageant will begin at 11:00 a.m.

Queens Pageant: *Interviews begin for Junior to Mrs. @ 2:00 p.m. sharp, no exceptions.

Each contestant must be ready to interview at 2:00 p.m.

*Pageant begins at 5:00 p.m.

*Admission \$10.00 which includes a program.

*Backstage and side doors will be locked at ALL times! NO ENTRY or EXIT unless it is an emergency! Contestants are not allowed in the auditorium on the day of the pageant. Each Contestant will stay in their assigned dressing room until it is your turn to line up for the stage. There will be no peeking in the side doors that lead to the auditorium, or any guests allowed backstage other than one adult with each contestant. We are to remain lady-like and quiet during the pageant. There will be no running, jumping or horseplay at any time on the campus of South Columbus Highschool or during the pageant. You will be responsible for any damage that is created by you or your party during rehearsal or the pageant. South Columbus High School has 24-hour camera surveillance in the halls, auditorium, and on the grounds.

There will be no cameras in dressing rooms and/or restroom facilities.
